- Championship start time: 10:00am

Entry fees:

- £12 for individual kata or kumite or £20 to enter both categories
- £5 per spectator (aged 16 years and above)

Registration:

- Email your club entry forms (competitor + referee/judge/timekeeper!) to technical@jka-england.org by the end of Friday 22 November 2019. You will receive confirmation of receipt.
- Transfer your payment to JKAE Account Number 20062146, Sort code 20-90-57. Payment must be received by Monday 25 November 2019. Please add reference: club/country name + competition eg: "Westminster competition" or "Oasis competition".

Please note:

- Each Club/organisation should submit both a competitor registration form and a Referee/Judge/Timekeeper form.
- Club chief instructors (or club representative) should submit the entry forms. No individual entries.
- Competitors, Judges/Referees plus the Club's Chief Instructor must all hold a valid JKA England Membership Licence on the day of the Championships (which they may be asked to produce) and belong to a currently affiliated JKA England Club. Any queries relating to current membership please email membership@jka-england.org.
- Each club is required to nominate an individual who, on the day of the Championships, will act as their coach and be responsible for collecting the competitor entry numbers, labels and details.
- Age and grade of a competitor is at the closing date for entries, Friday 22 November 2019, not the date of the championships. Please check these details before entering your students.
- If there are not enough entries in a category, the competitors will be moved to the next appropriate category.
- Late entries may not be randomised and could all be placed at the end of the category in one grouping.
- Gis must not display national team badge – club badges or blank gis only.
- Kata & kumite categories, rules and safety information please refer to the "JKAE Open Championship 2019 Categories and Rules of Entry" document.
- Photographs and video footage will be taken throughout the event. These will be used for marketing and publicity in our publications, on our website and on social media or in any third party publication. Kindly contact the event organiser if you have any concerns or if you wish to be exempted from this activity.
